



## REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSFER WITHIN PUBLIC SCHOOLS

**These requirements are for students currently attending public school in St. Croix.**

*For new students K5 – grade 12 please see the REQUIREMENTS FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL REGISTRATION listing*

**TRANSFERS ARE DONE ON MONDAY – THURSDAY 8:30 – 3:00 P.M.**

**LEGAL ACTION WILL BE TAKEN IF DOCUMENTS ARE FALSIFIED**

The documents required for transfer are:

- **Completed and signed Withdrawal/Transfer form** (obtained from the attending school).
- **Proof of Court Appointed Guardianship/Adoption Documents** (if child is not living with one or both natural parents)
- **School Records:**
  - Final or last issued Report Card of student entering 1<sup>st</sup> through 9<sup>th</sup> grades.
  - Official Transcript of students entering 10<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grades.
- **Government issued photo ID** of Parent or Legal Guardian.

● **Proof of Residency in St. Croix, US Virgin Islands:**

Homeowners – Two (2) required:

1. Signed Closing Statement **OR** deed of Property **OR** Property Tax Bill
2. Recent WAPA Bill.

Renters – Two (2) documents required:

1. Lease signed by both parties  
A recent WAPA Bill (*WAPA bill is still required when the lease includes utilities*)

**If the lease is not available:**

1. A notarized Landlord's Affidavit for Renters must be completed and returned with a recent rent receipt from the Landlord. *This Affidavit is available at the Division of Student Services or on the department's website at [www.vide.vi](http://www.vide.vi) under the "Divisions" tab, then choose "Student Services".*
2. A recent WAPA bill

**When parent/guardian and student live with a friend or family member:**

1. A notarized Residence Affidavit must be completed. *This Affidavit is available at the Division of Student Services or on the department's website at [www.vide.vi](http://www.vide.vi) under the "Divisions" tab, then choose "Student Services".*
2. Lease, signed by both parties **OR** signed closing statement **OR** Deed **OR** Property Tax Bill, verifying the residency of the friend or family member.
3. A recent WAPA Bill of the friend or family member.
